

Disposal of Cement Bonded Asbestos at Household Recycling Centres



Due to the hazardous nature of cement bonded asbestos it can only be accepted at a facility with a special licence issued by the Environment Agency. Three of Wiltshire household recycling centre's can accept cement bonded asbestos - **by appointment only***.

** N.B. Disposal of cement bonded asbestos is **by appointment only**, please telephone the appropriate number above to arrange an arrival time. You will need to bring a proof of address with you e.g. recent utility bill and photo I.D.*

Conditions of Use

1. You must be a resident of Wiltshire (excluding Swindon – see point 6 below) and have proof of residency (see Point E below).
2. The cement bonded asbestos must be arising from a domestic property e.g. a shed roof, drainpipes, water tank.
3. You have less than 12 sheets of cement bonded asbestos.
4. If you answer 'NO' to any of the above you **cannot** use Wiltshire's HRCs to dispose of your asbestos waste. Please refer to the contact information below.
5. **It is advised that you provide your own protective equipment – mask, gloves, overalls. Without these you will not be permitted to dispose of the asbestos.**
6. If it is any other type of asbestos you must contact a specialist contractor for disposal.

Once you have made your appointment * you must:

- A. Dampen down and wrap all asbestos in plastic
- B. Make sure all your pieces are manageable i.e. Not bigger than 2m x 2m
- C. Bring along help as staff are not able to assist
- D. Supply your own personal protective equipment e.g. Gloves, overalls, mask
- E. Bring proof of address e.g. Recent utility bill and photo ID (passport or drivers licence).
